

# TENTATIVE PLANS MADE FOR COMMUNITY CENTER

Tentative plans for a Jewish center were formulated at a meeting of the Young Folks' league held last night at the Talmud Torah hall, Third avenue East and Third street. The league plans to construct a modern building to be the center of activities. Bulletins and figures showing the advantages of such action were presented at the meeting.

On Sunday Oct. 24, a mass meeting of the Jewish population of the city will be held, and more definite action on the proposed center will be taken. It is the object of the younger members of the league to obtain co-operation of a rabbi to assist in developing the plans. Dr. eBenjamin Plotkin, was in the city for several days, and who has been instrumental in organizing the Young Folks' league, has returned to New York city.
