

# **SPEEDING AUTOS STRIKE DOWN TWO IN ACCIDENT TOLL**

## **One Run Over; Driver of Car Speeds On; Man Injured in Fall.**

A probable fracture of the left arm and probable internal injuries were sustained by Joseph Braverman 314 East Fifth street, cantor at the Adas Israel synagogue, when he was run over by an automobile at Fourteenth avenue East and First street late last night. The police failed to locate the owner of the automobile that figured in the accident.

The injured man was taken to St. Luke's hospital by Walter T. Wright, 320 North Sixteenth avenue East. Wright said he saw the injured man lying in the street, as he was traveling eastward. He added that he had noticed another automobile and a motorcycle going west, shortly before he reached the scene of the accident.

Wright was taken into custody by the police on a charge of driving an automobile in an intoxicated condition. He was released on \$100 to appear in municipal court this morning.

Gust Keller 409 Atlantic avenue, is in St. Luke's hospital with a broken leg, as a result of a collision yesterday morning between a motorcycle he was driving and an automobile driven by Steve Thelsen.

According to police officials, Thelsen was coming down Third avenue West, when obstructions to his view caused him to crash into Keller. The motorcycle was demolished. Thelsen is a driver for Miller's cafeteria.
