

# DULUTH RABBI ANSWERS ANTI-SEMITIC ATTACK

Refutations on recent anti-Semitic attacks, made particularly through the Dearborn Independent magazine, published by Henry Ford, were made last night by Rabbi Israel Lebendiger, in a sermon preached at Talmud Torah, Third avenue East and Third street.

"The monster of anti-Semitism is again raising its manifold heads," said Rabbi Lebendiger. "It again is trying to inject its virulent and deadly poison into the hearts and minds of innocent people. In Germany, in France, and of late, startling as it may sound, in our own great and glorious United States, magazines are being issued in which the Jew is being maligned," he said.

"The interdependence between the status of the Jew and the standard of civilization of his adopted fatherland, proves and is also explained by the fact that the Jew is an invaluable factor in the progress of the world. The story of Jews in many lands is nothing else but a repetition of the story of Joseph who came to Egypt as a slave and by his industry and application, became, next to Pharaoh, the greatest power in the land."
