VIRGINIA, Dec. 4.—Emil Maki had an economical streak yesterday. Facing the coming winter, he sought to secure a pair of pants without parting with the equivalent in cash. To accomplish this he attempted to walk off with an \$11 pair of pants from the Ben Walt Clothing store. But luck was against him.
