

PRESBYTERIANS AT EVELETH LEND CHURCH TO ZIONISTS

EVELETH, March 14.—In the First Presbyterian church of Eveleth tonight the cause of Zionism was advanced when members, by taking special pledges and an offering, turned over a fund to the local Zionist treasurer, Nathan Karlinsky, for the Zionist cause. More than 100 Jews from all parts of range were present.

Rev. William Jobush, pastor of the church, spoke on "Zionism, the Hope of Israel."

Rabbi Sugarman, Virginia, read the thirtieth chapter of Deuteronomy and gave a brief talk. Rabbi Silverman, Eveleth, read the one hundredth and nineteenth Psalm responsively.
