

SUPERIOR JEWS TO START DRIVE

Campaign to Raise Funds for Work in Palestine to Be Started.

Plans for a campaign to raise \$3,500, for restoration work in Palestine, will be completed at a meeting of Superior Zionists at Moose hall tonight. Charles Aronovich will be in charge of the meeting which will open at 8.

The meeting is a part of the nation-wide drive about to be launched for \$10,000,000 to prepare Palestine for the anticipated return of thousands of Jews when Turkey relinquishes her hold on the Holy Land. The drive, according to plans of leaders, is to be nonsectarian and will not be accompanied by personal solicitation.

Officers of the Superior Zionist organization, in charge of the drive, are H. A. Aronsohn, vice chairman; Pesach Goodin, secretary; Case Marcus, treasurer; Aaron Siegel, Edward Lasky, Sam Cort and Hyman Cedar, together with officers of the organization, constitute the executive committee.
