

REVOLT ORGANIZER KILLED

Bolsheviki Execute Chief of First Russian Revolution.

LONDON (AP)—Khrustaleff Nossar, chief organizer of the first Russian revolution has been executed by order of the soviet authorities because of his authorship of a pamphlet having the title "How Trotzky Sold Russia," according to a Moscow wireless which says news of the execution was received from Kiev.

Khrustaleff Nossar was arrested in Petrograd in 1905 for activities in a general strike. He was sentenced to exile in Siberia in January 1916. In April 1917 it was learned he had escaped from Siberia. He was next heard of in September 1917 when he proclaimed complete autonomy of the Pereyaslav district of Little Russia.
