

ROYAL NEIGHBORS WILL DECORATE GRAVES OF DEAD

Zenith camp, No. 1037, Royal Neighbors, will observe its annual Memorial day custom of decorating the graves of deceased members today. Mrs. George Murray, one of the charter members of the camp, will be in charge of the service, this being her seventh year in which she has acted in that capacity. The custom was first started seven years ago and has been kept up every year since. Purple and white pansies, the colors of the order, are planted, and small flags fashioned of ribbon of the same shades, are placed on the graves. Sixteen graves will be decorated. Of these, two are at Calvary cemetery, two at Forest Hill, one at the Jewish cemetery, and the remainder, 11, are at the Oneota cemetery.
