

MAX ZALK, DULUTH PIONEER, DEAD; TO BE BURIED TODAY

Max Zalk, a resident of Duluth since 1884, died at St. Mary's hospital at 4 o'clock yesterday afternoon, following an extended illness. He was born in Poland and came to the United States in 1884, moving to Duluth in that year. He was in business with the Duluth Iron & Metal company. Among the lodges of which he was a member are the Odd Fellows and B'nai B'rith.

Mr. Zalk is survived by his widow, one son, Louis of this city, and two daughters, Mrs. Jacob Wilk and Mrs. Robert Buchman of New York, formerly of Duluth. Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock this afternoon with burial at Adaph Israel cemetery.
