

CHARGE OF SPEEDING COSTS

DEFENDANT \$20 FINE IN COURT

Nick Colich pleaded guilty to a charge of speeding and paid a fine of \$20 in municipal court yesterday. Sam Vertelney, charged with parking over 20 minutes, pleaded guilty and was given a suspended sentence on payment of \$2 costs.
