

ELASTIC-TOPPED HOSE

INVENTED BY DULUTHIAN

Claims for a patented wool elastic topped knitted sock have been granted I. Garon of Duluth by the United States patent office, Washington, D. C. Mr. Garon, who is president of a Duluth manufacturing company, is the inventor not only of the patented sock but also of equipment required to manufacture the heavy knitted hosiery.

The claims for the wool elastic topped sock stipulate a hose number that requires no pins or garters to held up.

Applying the wool elastic top idea toward use for the wristlet part of heavy work mittens at present is engaging Mr. Garon, who is working on machinery to manufacture them.
