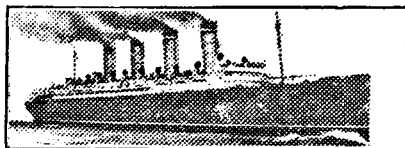

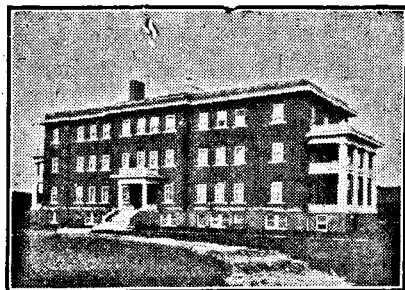

finest in the history of St. Cloud

the precursor of a Religious School.
