

MAN CHARGES NEIGHBOR, IN REVENGE, SMEARED HIS LIGHTS

VIRGINIA, Aug. 5.—A case where painting another's windows was indulged in as a method of revenge was brought into municipal court to-day by Philip Sigel of Virginia, who charged Louis Ronas with having daubed paint all over the windows of his home.

Sigel testified that, in his opinion, Ronas defaced his property following a quarrel over the location of a chicken coop. Ronas stated that he was painting his own home, which adjoins Sigel's, and that if any paint was daubed on Sigel's windows it was accidental.

Judge Bliss took the case under advisement.
