"Men think that because the modern age has produced so many inventions and made such progress in science, that they cannot and should not have their lives shaped and

the morals of the Bible,

"Science, without the control of
rorals, leads to ruin and disaster, as
evidenced by the late war. It makes
no difference to the Almighty
whether we run our factories by
steam or electricity, but it does make
a difference whether we are running
cur factories for good purposes.

"The Jews are the martyred race

of mankind. The Jew is now passing through the worst crisis in his history. Postroms, persecutions and expulsions are the common lot of Jews in European countries. Anti-Semi-tiem is spreading its writtent postronic all over the world. But the Jew finds consolation in the fact that he surfers for an ideal, and is willing to make sacrifices for it.—the ideal of

monotheism."
