

Business Man Acts as His Own Counsel

A man in business in Superior for 30 years, yesterday left his business to act as his own attorney as plaintiff in a civil action in municipal court. He is M. M. Sher of the Sher Cash and Carry groceries, 1015 Tower avenue, who is suing the James S. Kirk company of Chicago for a claim of \$18.50.

Sher although making several technical mistakes in the conduct of his case, examined and cross-examined witnesses with despatch.

The case involves a claim which Sher says is due him for a drop in prices of soap he had purchased, which he alleges he was guaranteed by a salesman for the company. The company contended that the salesman had no authority to guarantee against any decline in price.

Judge F. S. Parker took the case under advisement and will render a decision tomorrow.
