

Virginia Court Calendar Contains Only Civil Cases

Virginia, Dec. 23.—(Special.)—Session of district court will be devoted to the trial of civil cases this week. Oscar Scholeber, deputy clerk, said only civil actions would be tried because of the large number of untried cases on the December term docket. Trial of criminal actions will be resumed next week.

Cases to be heard in Judge Edward Freeman's branch of district court tomorrow are John and Jacob Saari against Palmy and Alto, Gust Hendrickson against Andrew Grande, August Laurila against St. Louis River Farmers Insurance company, and Charles T. Murphy, Paul A. Miller against Louis Cohen et al, Mary Picciano against City of Eveleth, Joseph Garon against Oscar Sjoblom, and Harry C. Martin against James Meehan et al.

Only two cases are listed for Thursday. They are Nestor Johnson against the Angora Lumber company and Stanley Borich against the Village of Kinney.
