

Hibbing Alumni Will Suggest Trophy Room In New High School

HIBBING, Feb. 5.—Facilities in the new Hibbing high school, now in course of construction at South Hibbing, will be the subject of discussion of members of the Hibbing high school alumni association to be held Feb. 10, in the study hall of the Lincoln building.

A proposal that the gymnasium in the new building be constructed to offer larger seating capacity is expected to be acted upon, according to

Israel Sher, president of the association. The large gymnasium is needed if Hibbing is to secure basket ball and other athletic tournaments, it is asserted.

That a trophy room to be set aside in the new building exclusively for the purpose of keeping pictures of athletic team, records of the teams, banners, cups, footballs used in big games and basket balls, will also be suggested at the meeting.

Organization of the alumni marching club will also be perfected. The carnival committee will announce final arrangements for the alumni marchers.
