

# JUDAISM TERMED PRACTICAL RELIGION IN RABBI'S SERMON

"Judaism, is a practical religion—it stands for practical idealism, if we may so express it," said Rabbi Israel Lebediger in a sermon last night at the Duluth Hebrew Institute.
