can Lumberman of Chicago. Each

week sees an increase in the number

of homes being bullt Big building operations continue slow in development, though there is very evident tendency to start building of this character. For example, one Chicago firm of architects. specializing in bank architecture, uas within the last week received orders to draw plans for three bank buildings of considerable size.

As a matter of fact, architects' offices are crowded with preparation of plans, not only for individual homes, but for bigger buildings. The people are hungry for homes and indications point to an early boom in building for practically every section of the coun-This boom, of course, is contingent upon reduction in the price of some materials which have as yet

fallen little, if any, and then the maintenance of reasonably stable prices. The volume of wholesale sales of lumber has shown some increase, but this branch of the trade is much more sluggish than is the retail end. That is, while retail lumbermen are expe-

riencing a better demand, they con-tinue to buy on a hand-to-mouth basis and are not placing orders for their annual requirements.

Production remains at a very low and shipments.
