

SUPERIOR MAN CLAIMS ASSESSOR 'GYPED' HIM

A suit to recover money paid on his income tax, which he claims was too high, was filed in Superior court by Roy Edelstein, 1708 Ogden avenue, against the city of Superior yesterday.

Edelstein claims that in making out his income tax returns for 1910 he made a mistake and that George Bubar, assessor of incomes, assessed him more than was required.

A stipulation was made yesterday by H. V. Gard, attorney for the plaintiff, and T. L. McIntosh, waiving the right of a trial by jury.
