

QUEEN CITY, BIG VILLAGE AFTER 2 CONVENTIONS

Virginia in 1922, Hibbing in
1924, Will Be Slogans at
Winona Sessions.

HIBBING, July 12.—"The American Legion State convention at Hibbing in 1924."

This will be the Hibbing delegation's slogan at the state convention to be held in Winona, Aug. 1 to 3. It was decided at a meeting of the Cobb-Williams post last night, Hibbing's delegation will include Floyd Farnand, Robert Hanson, William Furlong, John Gannon and Israel Sher. Dan Sullivan, Ed Higgins and Martin Healy were named alternates.

The post agreed to support Virginia's bid for the convention for 1922. The following year the state meeting will probably go to southern Minnesota, and 1924 Hibbing will seek the meeting. The Loom will be started early in order to give it impetus when the time of the actual fight for the convention begins.

Special Train.

A special train will carry northern Minnesota delegates directly from Duluth to Winona, July 31. The convention opens the following day.

Concessions at the county fair grounds will be obtained by the Legion during the fair in September. It was announced at the meeting last night.

VIRGINIA, July 12.—Five Legion men have been elected to go to Winona for the state American Legion convention Aug. 1, 2 and 3 to get the 1922 convention for Virginia. The instructions given the delegates make emphatic this point, and the delegates in turn promise to do all in their power to bring the convention back.

Those elected as delegates are Mayor William Emple, D. W. Hayes, Jalmer Johnson, Sam Cohen, and Jack Melroy, alternates Joe Carhart, Dr. Holland T. Grounds, Ed Moon, Dr. Rowe and A. C. Ambuchon.

Has Good Chance.

Posts throughout the range have signified their intentions of supporting the local organization in securing the 1922 meet and it is generally conceded that the Queen City has more than a fair chance of being chosen.

The Legion has also gone on record favoring the erection of a new hotel in the city, but declared itself opposed to selling five lots of the city hall building site for this purpose.
