

Badger Fire Marshal Conducts Probe Into Blazes at Superior

Charles Good, federal fire marshal from Ashland, Wis., has completed his investigation of several fires in Superior. The full report of his investigations will be learned in a few days according to District Attorney Robert Kennedy.

Three fires were investigated by Mr. Good during the week, Kennedy said. The most recent of the fires to be investigated is that which occurred last week at 1318 Tower avenue. The building is occupied by the Leader Department store. The fire started in the rear of the building.

Fire Chief Ole Norman investigated the cause of the fire. It was evidence of suspected incendiarism found by the fire chief that the investigation by Mr. Good was asked according to Kennedy.

Joseph Vertelney, proprietor of the store, was questioned by the fire chief and fire marshal.

Two other fires, one in Superior and the other in the country also were investigated. Evidence in one of them he said was sufficient to have warrants issued.
