

No Arrests In Fourth Avenue Store Robbery

The local police stated Wednesday night that as yet no arrests have been made in connection with the robbery of the Paletz grocery at 825 Fourth avenue. Entrance to the store was made Tuesday some time after 11 p. m. and about \$25 worth of provisions and a small amount of cash taken.

The thief broke the light of glass in the front door and turned the Yale catch to gain entrance, making off with bread, butter, eggs, cheese, lard and a quantity of canned goods. There was also about \$5 in the cash register which was taken, although the safe was not disturbed.

The police believe that the goods were taken by some family man who is out of employment, and footprints in front of the store Wednesday morning indicated that it was the work of an adult.

The robbery was discovered Wednesday morning when I. P. Paletz, proprietor of the store, arrived to open it up.
