

Hungry Duluth ex-service men yesterday continued to throng about the tables at Foresters' hall for the free noon-day meal being provided daily by a committee headed by Mrs. E. Hallock. Ninety-eight former soldiers and sailors who are penniless and jobless were fed. Monday 158 were given free meals.

Mrs. Hallock issued a plea to Duluthians to support the plan to feed ex-service men during the critical period of unemployment.

"A heavy burden has been placed on the committee," she said. "This work cannot be continued unless the public lends greater support. With co-operation the plan can proceed successfully and without the present attendant difficulties.
