

Brothers Play They Are Hunters, One Dead

Accidentally discharging a single barrellled shotgun, Herman Turnboom, age 10, shot his brother Kenneth, age 16, in the throat last Sunday night at Elmer, Minn., resulting in his death 45 minutes later. The brothers were playing they were hunters. Herman had possession of the gun while his older brother held a harmless air rifle in his hand.

Dr. Samuel Litman of Meadowlands was summoned after the shooting but when he arrived the boy already was dead.

Dr. C. F. McComb, county coroner, returned from Elmer yesterday and pronounced death resulting from the accidental discharge of the shotgun.

The boys lived with their parents, Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Turnboom, on a farm at Elmer. Four sisters also survive. Funeral services will be conducted today at Meadowlands.
