

Virginia Takes Steps to Help City's Needy

Virginia, Nov. 24.—(Special.)—The board of directors of the Chamber of Commerce at its meeting tonight considered the plan of reviving the Associated Charities society in Virginia.

The attention of the chamber to the need of such an organization was pointed out by a group of local citizens who have made visits of investigation among some of the families in the city, whom they assert are badly in need of organized assistance. Several of those visited were widows with large families and in other instances, families lacked the bare necessities due to sickness or other unfortunate circumstances.

About a month ago the board of directors of the Charities society called two meetings but there was a poor response at both meetings and the directors decided that unless some one else took the initiative it would be disbanded. For this reason the Chamber of Commerce was asked to consider the plan of continuing the organization under a paid secretary.

11 Houses on New School Site Sold in Chisholm

Chisholm, Nov. 24.—(Special.)—Eleven houses on the new site of the new high school building were sold at public auction this afternoon. The Medvid house on the corner of Third avenue South and Hemlock street, brought the highest price of any at the sale, R. V. Jackson paying \$2,450.

The Dr. Nelson house was purchased by Mr. Goldenberg for \$1,750, while the garage at the Nelson home sold for \$275. The Diacocevlch home on West Poplar street brought the third highest money, being purchased by the former owner for \$1,300. The Propotnik house on the corner of Poplar and Third avenue South, sold for \$1,100. The purchase price of the other dwelling ran from \$600 to \$1,000. Eight of the 12 houses purchased by the school board were not sold today.
