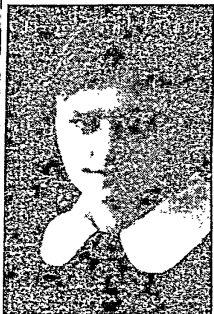


Cloquet High School To Graduate Largest Class in Its History
