

Institute Has Special Feast of Weeks Service

Special services for children and adults were held yesterday at the Hebrew institute in observance of the first day of Shabuoth, or the Feast of Weeks. Songs, talks and entertainment featured the services held for the children. The Feast of Weeks is observed when the children of the religious school have attained a practical knowledge of Biblical history and of Jewish religious beliefs.

Rabbi Israel Lebendiger will conduct the special services to be held this morning at the Hebrew institute and during the afternoon at the Adas Israel synagogue.

A joint Shabuoth and confirmation service will be held Sunday by the congregation of Temple Emmanuel at the First Unitarian church. Sunday is the last day of the observance. The services will begin at 10 a. m. From 2 to 5 o'clock Sunday afternoon a public reception in honor of the confirmants will be held in the vestry room of the church. Seven children will be given confirmation certificates by I. Friemuth, president of the congregation. Rabbi Alvin S. Luchs will deliver the address.
