

Suit Over Building to Be Dropped; Structure Sold

Gilbert, Sept. 21.—(Special.)—With the purchase today of the building at Broadway and Minnesota avenues by Alfred Hoel, President of the First National bank, the \$10,000 damage suit instituted by A. Nathanson, Virginia, former owner of the building against the village of Gilbert will be dismissed.

Nathanson, in his action, charged the village with carelessness in constructing retaining walls under the walk to take care of the flow of water from a corner drinking fountain. As a result, he alleged, one side of the two-story building sunk five feet. Hoel will remodel the building for office purposes.
