

Fruits Reported Stolen From Grocery Warehouse

Harry Soloski, 407 John avenue, of the Central Meat market, 1704 North Twelfth street, reported to Superior police yesterday that a warehouse owned by the Central Grocery corporation at 1713 Twelfth street, was broken into Sunday night and a large quantity of fruits stolen. He told police that the knob of the door, in which the robbers gained entrance, was broken, and also that the window on the door was broke. Bars on a rear door were bent, according to Soloski.

A check of all the goods stolen have not been made, men at the meat market said last night.
