truck firm, were served with notices of the appeal. The case is set for hearing March 24 in this city at the regular term of district court. Following granting of a permit last August to the Gopher concern, the commission issued a stay of order on protest of the railroad. Hearings were held here and at Duluth. On January 3, this year, the state body issued an order reaffirming the original certificate. The D. & I. R., then filed notice of appeal to the courts asking that trial be held at Ely. The truck line is now in operation from Aurora to

Tower, Ely and Winton.
