## Name Supervisor

Oliva Viola, psychiatric social worker, formerly on the Oakland Clinic staff, has been appointed supervisor of the branch, located at 386 E. Maple

Seated in her office, which promises to be extremely attractive with its brown and beige wallpaper, white woodand shuttered windows, Miss Viola explained:

"Children living in the Birmingham - Bloomfield-Franklin area may be referred to us by parents, physicians, schools, social agencies or courts.

#### Interview Parents

"Our first step is to interview the child's parents. Then the child is given a psychological examination and, if neces sary, a psychiatrist is brought in. Reports of the parents, the psychologist and the psychiatrist are evaluated, and a plan of treatment worked out.

"Fees are charged, but they are based on income and size of the family." From the hundreds of cases

Miss Viola has worked on in the past, she selected two to illustrate something of what the clinic hopes to accomplish.

## Tommy Fails

She said: "Tommy, a sturdy child of 8, was referred to us by his teacher, who was worried because he had failed two years n a row, and still retained the habit of sucking his thumb.

"His father was pre-occupied with business, and his mother had emotional problems of her own, so neither gave Tommy the attention and understand-ing he needed.

## Reports Alone

"The mother reported for an interview alone the first time, and shortly after, brought Tommy in for a psychological test. We found he had adequate intelligence, but didn't try to learn because he was

"Over a period of months, Tommy's mother was assisted in gaining a better understanding of her own problems, and of her obligations toward her

"The father began to take more time off from work to be with his family, and Tommy started to improve.

## Grades Improve

"After 18 months, Tommy stopped sucking his thumb and was doing average school work. "Sometime later, Susic, 6, was brought in by her mother. Every morning when it was time for school, Susie would

develop a stomach ache, and

begin to cry and cling to her

"We learned Susie was an only child, and her mother was over-protective and lacked confidence in her child. Susie reacted by being unable to adjust to life away from her mother.

### In Short Time

"In a relatively short timethree or four months—we were able to help the mother 'let go' of her child, and to bolster her confidence in herself.

"Susie was encouraged to be more independent, gradually the stomach aches stopped, and she was able to go off to school cheerfully."
