Home safety should include a course in handling firearms, a national expert on safety said at the first Home Safety Workshop of its kind ever held

"There is an average of one firearm-pistol, rifle, shotgun -to every home in Ohio," said Phil Dykstra, home department manager of the National Safety Council in Chicago, at the workshop sponsored by the Greater Cleveland Safety Council in the Higbee Co. Auditorium.

HE RECOMMENDED a course covering special storage of firearms with ammunition elsewhere, the disassembling of guns, and the cleaning of weapons.

Last year 1,200 persons were killed by firearm accidents in their own homes, Dykstra


