Jerry was a true entrepreneur starting with owning and operating Stein Rexall Drugs in Hibbing MN along with his brothers-in-law, Alan Stein and David Oxman. While at the drug store he embarked on a new venture, opening The Koney Express. It proved to be so successful that he had multiple kiosks throughout the Iron Range and culminated in to having a food booth at the MN State Fair. He continued with running the booth at the Fair for 25 years where the Koney Sandwich was voted Best New Food. His passion with food never wavered and there wasn't an Asian meal that he could say no to. He is survived by his wife of 72 years, Leone (Stein); daughter, Nancy (Bruce Macdonald); son, Larry (Patti Tollerud Altman); grandsons, Oliver Macdonald, Zach, Josh and Max Altman; and many nieces and nephews.
