brought to Duluth. time of the fatality the mother was hurrying by a fast ocean

liner to New York where she was to

join her husband and fogether they were to come west to meet their sons. Unable to convey the sad message which would spoil the happy reunion the remaining son wired his father only that Harry had been injured in

an accident and that he need not worry as he would be well cared for.
