

**Dr. Ira T. Nathanson**

The body of Dr. Ira T. Nathanson, 50-year-old Harvard Medical School associate clinical professor of surgery, who died of a heart attack yesterday, will be removed to his native Virginia, Minn., for funeral services.

The noted cancer researcher, who lived at 16 Still st., Brookline, was stricken shortly after giving a medical lecture. Actual date of the funeral services will not be set until the body reaches Minnesota. He was head of the Massachu-

Massachusetts General Hospital's research in cancer surgery, consulting surgeon at Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary, assistant planner of the Shattuck Hospital, active in the state's cancer program and headed up cancer diagnosis and therapy for several groups including the National Research Council, Washington, D. C.

He was a graduate of Northwestern University and Medical School and was formerly resident surgeon at Pondville State Hospital and was assistant surgeon at Beth Israel Hospital from 1940 to 1944.

Besides his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Herman J. Nathanson of Virginia, Minn., he leaves a sister, Mrs. J. N. Urwitz of Toledo, O.
