OBITUARY OF LESTER H. YOFFE

Lester H. YOFFE, of Framingham, Massachusetts, passed away on Wednesday, June 06, in Agoura Hills, California, after a three year battle with lung cancer. He was born in Chelsea, Massachusetts, to the late Celia (Resnick) and Israel YOFFE and was an excellent student and athlete. In high school, he played center field on the baseball team. He is veteran of World War II and saw action with the 9th Army and participated in the Battle of the Bulge. He attended Purdie University and in 1949 received his BA from the University of Maine. Co-founder of the Montrose Day Camp in the late 50's, he went on to receive his Masters in Education from Northeastern University in 1960. His next stop was the John Elliot School in Needham, Massachusetts, where he taught 5th grade and accelerated math for over 25 years. An avid golfer, after retirement you would find him on the golf course at least three times per week, with the same friends he had been playing with for decades. He was married to the late Lucille (Antine) YOFFE for almost 44 years. He leaves behind a family and friends who loved him dearly. His sisters, Roberta KOLOVSON of Needham, and Barbara LEWIS of Sharon, two sons, Michael and David, and Michael's wife, Amy, and granddaughters, Rachel and Leah.
