FIRE AT MENANGA.

Four Hundred Thomand Foot of Lumber
Burned.

MENANGA. Minn, Sept. L.—For sereral days fercer forest fires have been

raging in this vicinity, and it has been only by the united efforts of the people who have worked day and night that the whole town has been kept from burning several times. Senday and Monday were sextiting days. The whole town fought fire with a vigor seidom equalled, and during the afternoon of the latter day they succeeded in getting it pretty well under control.

That night, wors out and tired, everyone retired early, but they were unable to secure the much needed rest. Toesday the cilizens were called out and found the Menahya Lumber Co's yards on fire. By persistent work it was extinguished after 400,000 feet of

lumber had been destroyed. _
