

STOLEN GOODS FOUND IN ROOM OF HOTEL LODGER

Property which John Hoff is claimed to have stolen from the second hand store of Litman Bros., 320 East Superior street, was recovered yesterday at the Marine hotel, 206 Lake avenue south, in the room occupied by Hoff. Among the articles found were a stocking full of cigars, several watches, men's underclothing, an overcoat, razors and a gun and case. Efforts to sell some of the goods, first got Hoff in trouble, but he claims that they were given him to dispose of by another man. He was evasive about giving the address of his hotel. The Litman store was entered and robbed Sunday night, and the proprietor has identified the goods found.
