

CHISHOLM SYNAGOGUE TO BE DEDICATED TODAY

CHISHOLM, June 28.—Tomorrow afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, dedicatory services will be held at the Jewish synagogue which is nearing completion. The work was started last fall and for lack of funds and due also to the severity of the winter, building operations were suspended until a few weeks ago, when the finishing work was again taken up. The building is located at the corner of Fourth avenue and Walnut street and will when completed cost about \$1,400. Rev. D. W. Kissin of St. Paul will make the address.
