

PASSOVER HOLIDAY ENDS WITH TONIGHT

Passover or Pesach came to a close at sundown last night for the reformed Jews, and will end tonight for the orthodox Jews. Special services were held last night in Temple Emanuel, and in the Adas Israel synagogue, where they will be repeated tonight.

The close of the holiday marks the end of the eating of the unleavened bread, or matzos.

Passover is the commemoration of the 40 years' wandering through the Desert by the Jews, after they left Egypt.
