

LOCAL HEBREWS WILL NOT BE REPRESENTED

Instead They Will Hold Conference Here and Forward Resolution to Convention.

In accordance with the preliminary conference for the organization and convention of the American Jewish congress, which will be held in Philadelphia Sunday and Monday, representatives of the various Jewish organizations in the city, will form a branch congress and organize in Duluth on Sunday.

The call for this sort of a conference has been indorsed by the heads of 20 nation-wide Jewish organizations. Thirty-one states in the union will be represented at the conference, comprising 95 committees, of which Minnesota will send two.

No representation will be sent from Duluth, because of the late report given to the local organizations. At the meeting Sunday, a resolution will be adopted on what the local organizations think, the purpose of the congress should be for, and sent immediately to Philadelphia. The organizations which will have representatives in the assembly held here are: Duluth City lodge, O. B. A.; Duluth Hebrew lodge, O. B. A.; Dr. Schechter's Zion camp; Sisters of Israel; Adas Israel congregation, and Kiseareth Israel congregation.
