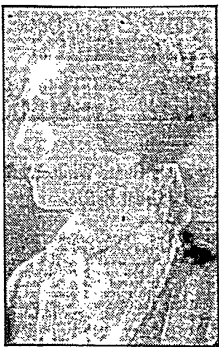


HER MARRIAGE TO IOWA MAN JAN. 14
