

ZIONIST SPEAKER WILL ADDRESS DULUTH JEWS

Jews of Duluth will hear another Zionist speaker next Saturday night. Dr. M. Sheinkin, a noted worker of the Zionist movement, will be in Duluth and speak at Adas Israel synagogue, Third street and Third avenue East, on that night. He will speak on land purchasing and colonization of Palestine after the war.

Dr. Sheinkin is a native of Russia and a graduate of the University of Philosophy and History in Odessa. He has been active in Russia's Zionist affairs since 1890. During that time he has attended all the congresses and served as a member of the great actions committee under Dr. Herzl. He also has been a rabbi in Balta, South Russia.

He has made his home in Palestine since 1914. When the war broke out he had trouble with the Turkish government because of his great Zionist work and was deported to Egypt. He came to America in April, 1916, and has been speaking in all the large cities since. His talk in Duluth Saturday will be given under the auspices of Duluth Zionist's societies.
