

DENFELD STUDENTS TO ORGANIZE DEBATE TEAM

Will Enter Contests for Garon Trophy With Other Head-of-Lakes Schools.

Work will be started this week at the Denfeld high school preparatory to the selection of debating teams. The question which will be discussed in the establishment of a minimum wage for workers. Approximately 15 students have declared themselves as candidates for one of the teams.

Three of the members of last year's debating teams are in school this year. Miss Bessie Merritt, Leslie Goodhand and Ralph Nichols, and R. J. Wilson, coach, expects with the material which has manifested itself during the past year, that he will be able to develop two strong teams.

The high school will contend for the Garon trophy again this year, and will arrange for debates with teams from the Twin Cities and from the range. Last year Denfeld defeated Duluth Central high school in the Garon trophy debate but lost to Superior Central high school. The team which was composed, of the three members of the two teams having the highest standings, defeated Cloquet, making a total of two victories out of three debates.
