

# AUTO OVERTURNS; ONE KILLED; THREE OTHERS INJURED

## Duluth Party, En Route to St. Paul, Meets With Accident. Winnipeg Visitor Victim.

One person was killed and three others, two of them from Duluth, were injured yesterday afternoon at Mattawa, Minn., when a touring car, bound from Duluth to St. Paul, overturned on a stretch of gravel road. Miss Ella Atkins of Winnipeg, Can., died soon after being taken to a hospital at Moose Lake, Minn.

Others in the party, whose injuries are not serious, were:

David S. Kenigsberg, 31 West Fifth street, Duluth.

Miss Pauline Dalborn, 3119 Wadena, West Duluth.

Max Polinski, Winnipeg, Can.

Kenigsberg, bookkeeper for Bloom & Co., furniture dealers at 25 West First street, Duluth, who was driving the car, according to information received last night, summoned assistance and all four were taken to the hospital. The accident occurred about 5 p. m.

Ella Atkins came to Duluth last Thursday. Pauline Dalborn's mother said last night, to visit with friends here. She became acquainted with Miss Dalborn and Kenigsberg and, with Polinski, the four formed a party to drive to St. Paul where, it is said, Miss Atkins wished to visit with relatives the remainder of the week.

Miss Dalborn's shoulder was slightly injured, Polinski has minor cuts about the head and Kenigsberg has a few bruises, according to the head nurse at the Moose Lake hospital. Miss Dalborn is 22 and Miss Atkins about the same age.
