

# *Buhl Police Free Two Suspects Held in Niemi Burglary*

## *Deputy Sheriffs Called Upon to Aid in Tracing House Breakers.*

BUHL, Oct. 4.—In an effort to put a stop to the wave of burglaries reported to the police during the last week, deputies from the county sheriff's office have been called to Buhl to investigate the latest crime reported. Two men taken in custody today following the burglary of the Charles Niemi home Saturday night, were given their freedom after they had proven to the authorities a satisfactory alibi.

The Niemi home was entered while the family was duck hunting and \$350 taken. In ransacking the home the thieves apparently overlooked \$800 in cash in a drawer of the dresser from which the \$350 was taken.

It is believed the same gang was implicated in the burglary of the Crolberg building, occupied by Madalle brothers, late Saturday night. A window at the rear of the place was forced and the cash register cleaned of cash. No merchandise was touched. Police are working on the theory that thieves who operated so successfully at Hibbing last week have transferred their activities to this city.
