Mitchell Adam Dubow, 83, died Wednesday, Jan. 11, 2006, at the Scottsdale Hospital.

He was born March 24, 1922, in Portsmouth, Va., the son of Morris and Dora (Sykes) Dubow. He proudly served in the Army during World War II in the European Theater. He moved from Baltimore, Md., to Virginia in 1947, when he married Barbara Cohen on May 8, 1947. Their marriage and family was the center of his life. He joined his father-in-law, Sam Cohen, a longtime Virginia resident, in the practice of law. Minnesota Gov. Rudy Perpich appointed him to the St. Louis County District Court, where he served until his retirement.

He moved to Prescott, Ariz., 16 years ago, upon his retirement as a judge in Minnesota. He was very active in his community, especially the Friends of the Precott Public Library, serving as president and as a board member. He enjoyed listening to classical music, playing bridge and discussing politics.

Mitchell was a devoted husband and father, an unselfish and dedicated man whose living example of love, kindness and devotion was an inspiration to his family and friends.

Mitchell is survived by his daughters, Nancy Dubow of Prescott and Ondine Webb De Mer (Evan Saunders) of Seattle, Wash.; a son, Robert (Jacqueline) Dubow, of Arlington, Va.; grandchildren, Paul and Clara; and nieces, Andee and Donna.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Barbara, in June 2005; daughter, Debra Dubow; and brother, Bemie Dubow.
