

LUZER KARON.

Quite suddenly and unexpectedly occurred the death of Luzer Karon last Sunday, March 7, at the home of his daughter and son-in-law, Mrs. and Mr. J. J. Rivkin. Death was due to general debility, the deceased having attained the age 78 years.

Luzer Karon was a native of Russia and was a Hebrew by birth. His wife, Lena Karon, died in 1878. He came to America twenty-one years ago. He is now mourned by five children, Mrs. J. J.
