Obituary for Rose Kay

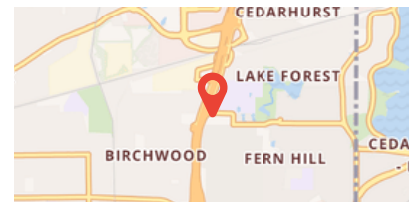
